Mangoes Restaurant is recognised as being simply the most incredible on the island of Vila. The impressive menu features a myriad of fine cuisine that includes dishes using the freshest local seafood and the finest cuts of Vanuatu's renowned beef. The 29 spacious and wonderfully comfortable bures all feature their own private balcony, from which to fully enjoy the surroundings. 8 bures have their own private plunge pool.
